SPECIAL MEETING APRIL 3, 2020

The Grant County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session April 3, 2020 via Zoom. Chairman Sperr called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m., with the following members present: Bill LaValley, Dwight Walvatne, Troy Johnson, Keith Swanson and Doyle Sperr.

Tina Lindquist presented an update on Covid-19 related matters and discussed the use of the Land Management/Extension building for testing should additional an additional site be needed in the future.

A motion was made by Swanson seconded by LaValley and carried to authorize the use of the Land Management/Extension building for a Covid-19 testing site in a worst case scenario.

A request was made by the Sheriff's Office to increase the credit card limit for Tina McGrath during the Covid-19 event.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Swanson and carried to authorize a credit card limit increase to \$5,000 for Tina McGrath until the Covid-19 event in over.

Jim Standish presented four options to continue recycling program services for discussion. Consensus of the Commissioners was to explore working with Otter Tail County for collection of recycling through August 2020.
