

GRANT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING AUGUST 25, 2020

The Grant County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session July 25, 2020 at Elbow Lake, MN. Vice Chairman Walvatne called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Bill LaValley, Keith Swanson, Dwight Walvatne and Troy Johnson. Others: Chris Ray-Grant County Herald, Jeff Merrick, Tina Lindquist, Ashley Hokanson, Chad Van Santen and Ken Johnson.

Pledge Those in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Sperr joined the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
Commissioner LaValley left the meeting at 9:50 a.m.

CARES Act Discussion was held on the CARES Act funding to Grant County. Discussion items included internal county costs, sub recipient amounts, distribution to private businesses and an application process.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Swanson and carried to authorize the purchase of touchless water and toilets up the a total amount of \$8,000 for the courthouse and land management buildings.

A motion was made by Swanson seconded by Johnson and carried to allocate \$450,000 for county internal costs and sub recipients, \$198,484.4 for schools, \$22,675.00 for Public Health and \$102,928.60 in contingency.

Consensus of the Commissioners was do direct any private business or non-profit organization inquiring or wanting to request CARES funding to the city or township that the business is located in for application of funds.

There being no further business, the Chairman adjourned at 10:47 a.m.
