During these trying times, Ruby's Pantry is here for anyone looking to extend their monthly grocery budget. Each guest contributes a \$20 donation per share and receives an assortment of grocery items.

- Who:** Ruby's Pantry is for ANYONE that eats! There is no income or residency requirement.

How does distribution work?

- Distribution starts at 6 pm.
- Volunteers will have food set up in a single row in the parking lot so vehicles can drive down either side.
- Volunteers will place food in your vehicle, no need to get out of your vehicle.
- Please bring a box, laundry basket or bags that the volunteers can place your food in.
