

# 2015 Grant County Recycling

## Items accepted for recycling in Grant County

- **Newsprint:** include inserts i.e. Wal-Mart, Pamida, etc., **MAGAZINES**
- **Glass:** must be clean - brown, green, clear
- **Aluminum Cans**
- **Tin Cans:** must be clean - with or without paper labels
- **Plastic Bottles: #1 and #2 only (NO #3 - #7, NO automotive plastic containers - ex: HEET), NO clear plastic food trays**
- **Corrugated Cardboard**
- **Shredded Paper:** both high and low grade
- **Aluminum Foil:** must be clean and void of food
- **Telephone Books**
- **Paper:** white high grade paper & envelopes without windows
- **Brown Grocery Bags: NO salt softener bags (plastic or paper)**

**Ashby:** By City Office

**Barrett:** Northeast of Post Office

**Elbow Lake:** South side of town by County Garage

**Herman:** In alley by City Shed

**Wendell:** By Community Center

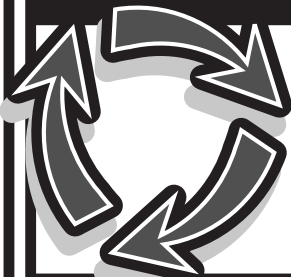

- **Separate** by item and put in either  **tied bag**  or boxes in appropriate compartment in trailer
- **No Dumping** loose items in the trailer. Must be in tied bags/boxes
- **Scrap Metals** belong at Metal Dropsite in Elbow Lake, not in trailers
- **Remove** lids and caps from plastic and glass products

Items not mentioned above **CANNOT** be recycled at this time
