

## **Grant County Social Services Biennial Service Agreement Plan**

Grant County Social Services is developing the Consolidated Children and Minnesota Family Investment Program Plan for 2010-2011. Citizen participation is invited in the development and the intended use of these funds, including the Title XX Social Services funding.

The Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) Consolidated Fund Act and the Children and Community Services (CCSA) Consolidated Fund (Minnesota Statutes 256J.626 and 256M, respectively) requires counties to submit a biennial service agreement to the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) to receive these public funds.

The primary purpose of the Biennial Service Agreement is to establish agreed upon outcomes and identify strategies counties will use to achieve these outcomes. The agreement also provides the State with a county needs statement for populations who may be served with funds covered under the agreement and a county budget for expenditures of those funds. The review and comment period ends on Thursday, October 15, 2009.
