

Permit Application Key

1. Lake/River No: The DNR protected waters number can be obtained from the Land Management Office. (only applicable for non-commercial turbines)
2. Lake/River Name: The DNR protected waters name can be obtained from the Land Management Office. (only applicable for non-commercial turbines)
3. Lake/River Classification: The DNR protected waters classification can be obtained from the Land Management Office. Lakes are divided into three classes; Natural Environment, Recreational Development, and General Development. WECS are not allowed within the Recreational Development and General Development district within Grant County. (only applicable for non-commercial turbines)
4. Section: Section numbers can be obtained from tax statement, deed, abstract or on the Grant County Website under Current Year Tax Info.
5. Township Name: Indicate township name(s).
6. Parcel Number: Parcel numbers can be obtained from your property tax statement or on the Grant County Website under Current Year Tax Info. This is a nine digit number (i.e. xx-xxxx-xx). For an aggregated project all parcel numbers should be included. (use additional paper if needed)
7. Property (E-911) Address: The address can be obtained from property tax statements or the Grant County website under Current Year Tax Info. If the parcel does not have a property address, leave blank. All parcels with family residences, and a part of project, should be included. (use additional paper if needed)
8. Legal Description: Legal descriptions can be obtained from your tax statement, deed, abstract, or on the Grant County Website under Current Year Tax Info. For example, NW1/4, NW1/4. (use additional paper if needed)
9. Property Owner(s): Print name of all property owners who are part of project. (use additional paper if needed)
10. Agent: Indicate if project has agent or consultant assisting in development of project .
11. Site Plan: All items listed should be noted and included in the project proposal. The project description should include; wind rights within project area, turbine and tower design with manufacturer's name, electrical system needs, project construction, operations and maintenance plans, and anticipated scheduling. The number of towers and total name plate generating capacity needs to be stated. For Commercial WECS additional items will need to be submitted unless approval in writing is given that it is not needed. The project engineer's signature as well as the official representative for the project is also required.

13. Single turbines non-commercial WECS may use the drawing sheet. More detailed drawings will be required for multiple turbine projects

Note: The application is a supplement for Commercial WECS when applying for a Conditional Use Permit.
